#### Sun America LLC and the Business Resource Network

Sun America LLC is a manufacturer of paper baking cups and plastic food containers. Starting in 1993 as a small family business manufacturing paper baking cups, it has grown to over 130 employees today. Thermoforming of plastic food trays and containers started with 1 machine in 2012 and has grown to 8 machines today, with 2 additional being added in 2023. This is a major area of growth projected over the next several years.

Sun America connected with OhioMeansJobs Stark and Tuscarawas Counties/Business Resource Network in 2019 to help with workforce/staffing challenges and expansion resources.

In both 2021 and 2022, Sun America provided employee training on their thermoforming machines. The Incumbent Worker Training Program (IWTP) program provided funding to help pay for this training. The training allowed employees to learn more about the functionality of the machines, to better adjust them, and become more efficient at operating them to produce a good product the first time.

Matt Falter, Project Director/Network Manager of Business Resource Network, and team have brought Sun America in touch with other resources to help with their future growth and expansion of our physical space to allow for more machines. Sun America is currently in the process of working with Team NEO to see what funding they might be eligible for to help with their growth and expansion.

Megan King, Human Resource Manager at Sun America states, "I always enjoy connecting with Matt (Falter). He is thorough and continuously follows up to see how things have been going with the business and see what current needs we have. Without the connection with Matt, we would not have found all the available resources to help in our growth. He is very knowledgeable about these available resources to help companies. ## New Programs on the Horizon for Buckeye Career Center Adult Education

Those seeking to further their education or training will have several new options to choose from at Buckeye Career Center in the fall of 2023. Medical Office Support and Esthetics will be offered as new full-time programs, allowing students to complete the course and earn industry-recognized credentials and a career-technical passport in nine months or less. Medical Office Support will train students to maintain medical records, code medical procedures and operations, assist healthcare professionals and more, while Esthetics is a 600-hour course to train students to become licensed skin care professionals who provide facials, hair removal, and other treatments.

In addition to full-time offerings, BCC also offers the Ohio Adult Diploma Program, which allows Ohioans, age 20 or older, to enroll in a specific program to earn a high school diploma and industryrecognized credentials related to that program. These programs are typically short-term and can last from a few weeks to a few months, with no cost to the student. New ADP courses for 2023-24 include FAA Part 107 Drone License Preparation, Ohio Pest Control Professional Applicator, Office Professional, Manufacturing and Warehousing Associate, Public Safety Communicator, and Basic Construction/Carpentry. Other ADP programs include Auto Tech, Level I Firefighter, Level II Firefighter, Phlebotomy, Nail Technician, STNA, and Welding (short course). These programs are also available to those who have already earned a high school diploma.

Other full-time programs include Cosmetology, Dental Assisting, HVAC-R, Heavy Equipment/ CDL A Operator, Law Enforcement Training Academy, Medical Assisting, Utility Lineworker, and Welding Technology.


