Buckeye Career Center (BCC) Enrolling for Fall Programs

Buckeye Career Center is still accepting applications for fall enrollment for full-time and part-time Adult Education programs. Most full-time courses are completed within nine months and run during the daytime and evening, to fit your schedule. Featured programs include Heating, Ventilating, Air Conditioning, & Refrigeration; Heavy Equipment/ CDL A Operator; Medical Assisting; Dental Assisting; and the Law Enforcement Training Academy. Students who successfully complete any of these programs will enter the workforce with the training needed to succeed in the field, including industry-recognized credentials and certifications, along with an Adult Education Career-Technical Certificate. Fees range for each program based on hours and costs. Financial aid is accepted for those who qualify. Buckeye Career Center also accepts local scholarship dollars for full-time programs

Additionally, BCC offers several short-term or career enhancement courses ranging from automotive, computer technology, special interest, professional development, health and safety, and industry and trades. Several of these programs are also Adult Diploma Program (ADP) eligible, which enables those seeking a high school diploma to earn a diploma, along with credentials and work-specific training. ADP enrollees must be at least 20 years of age and an Ohio resident.

BCC is also seeking to hire additional Adult Education instructors in the fields of Cosmetology, HVAC-R, Heavy Equipment, Medical Assisting, and Medical Office Support. Hours and work days vary based on the schedule of the specific program.

Use @Mentions to Get Someone's Attention By Microsoft Support

If you'd like to get someone's attention in an email message or a meeting invite, you can type the @ symbol, followed by their name, in the body of the email message or a meeting invite. If you do this, not only will their name be highlighted in the message body or invite details, but Outlook will automatically add them to the To line of the email or meeting invite, and they'll see the @ symbol next to the message in their Inbox.


