Buckeye Career Center Law Enforcement Training Academy Enrolling

Buckeye Career Center's Adult Education department is still accepting applications for its nine-month, Law Enforcement Training Academy through September 15th. The program prepares students for a career in law enforcement and successful graduates become certified peace officers by the Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission. Once certified, graduates could be employed as a deputy sheriff, marshal, deputy marshal, or police officer with an Ohio subdivision or organization.

Curriculum for the program follows the mandated standards of the Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission. Other obtainable certifications include standard field sobriety testing, speed measuring devices, firearms qualification, CPR First Aid, and a career-technical certificate.

The program is 800 hours and runs Monday-Friday from 6-10pm, plus approximately 10 weekends. The tuition is \$6,750 and fees are \$1,300. Financial aide is accepted for those who qualify. Local scholarships are also accepted

The **deadline to apply** and complete a physical fitness entry exam is **September 15**, **2023**. Anyone interested in the course should call the Buckeye Career Center Adult Education office at 330-339-2288 or visit www.BuckeyeCareerCenter.org for more information.


