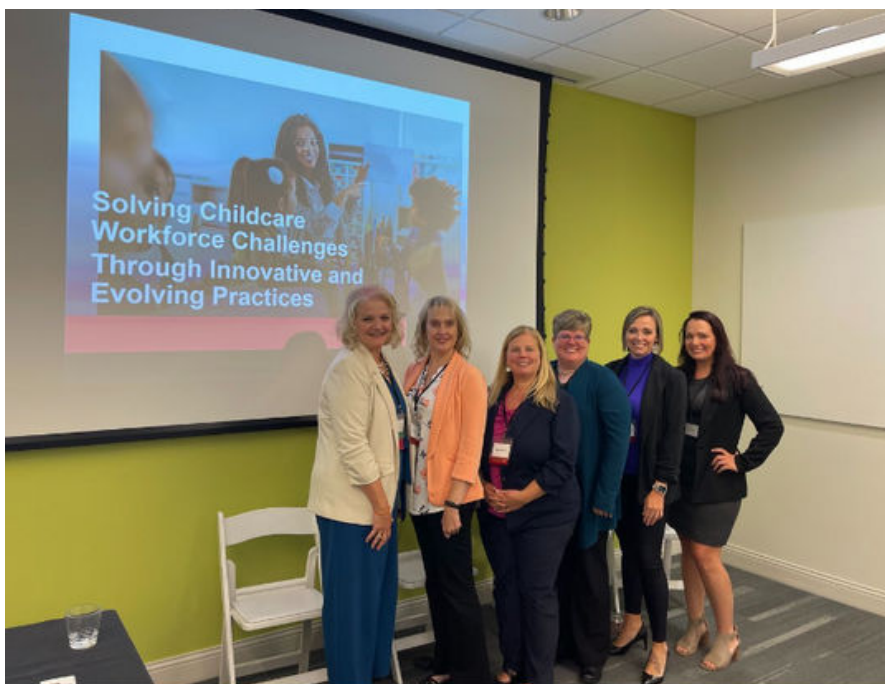
Ohio Workforce Association Holds Inaugural “Shaping Ohio’s Future Workforce” Conference

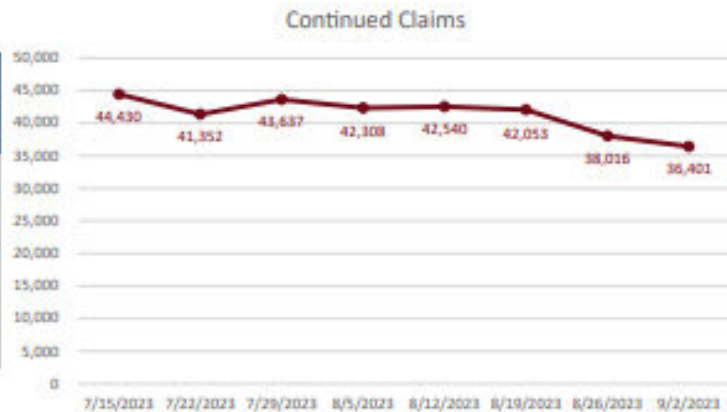
