Community Resource Fair

On Friday, October 27th, Goodwill hosted a Community Resource Fair where 46 different agencies were in attendance to provide resources to the community. Lori Douglass, Community Services Coordinator, attended to provide information about OhioMeansJobs Stark and Tuscarawas Counties. There were 79 visitors in total at the event.



Tuscarawas County Downtown Business Support Walks

On August 4th and 10th, 2023 Tuscarawas County Economic Development Corporation (TCEDC) staff coordinated Downtown Business Support Walks in New Philadelphia and Dover. The goal was to support our downtown small businesses by listening to their challenges and connecting them with people or resources to address those challenges. Both local mayors, city council members, the Chamber of Commerce, the Small Business Development Center, the Business Resource Network, and TCEDC staff talked with 15-20 business owners or managers in each downtown area. The biggest issue in both towns was adequate parking. There is limited off-street parking, and retail customers often struggle to find a spot. Another issue brought up numerous times was communication about special downtown events, such as car shows, festivals, live music, etc. It was discussed with local leaders how to get the word out more effectively about special events in a timely manner. Uneven sidewalks were also a concern for some business owners. Though the group couldn't address all of these issues on the spot, business owners were very grateful to have their concerns heard. All the participants agreed that this should be an annual event to stay in contact with our small business leaders.

On Monday, October 30th, the 37th Leadership Stark County Signature Class visited the OhioMeansJobs Center in Stark County in advance of Economic Development Day.

Partnership Development Sessions Showcase How Buckeye Career Center Can Help Area Employers

Area human resources professionals recently learned of the ways Buckeye Career Center can help local companies obtain skilled-employees. BCC hosted six sessions of the 2023 Workforce Development & Employee Training Summit, on October 18 and 25, to discuss workforce development and employee training topics. The sessions were led by Buckeye Career Center (BCC) Director of Curriculum, Instruction, & Adult Education, Mr. Frank Polen and Assistant Adult Education Director, Mr. Steve Rippeth.

Rippeth and Polen discussed Ohio's TechCred program, which allows employers to upskill current and future employees with industry-recognized credentials that can be earned at BCC, along with the Incumbent Worker Training program, which also supports skill development for existing employees. Attendees also learned about BCC's School-to-Work program, which allows employers to hire BCC high school students while they complete their senior year of high school.

"We are often asked how employers can get involved at BCC or what the process is to hire high school students, while they are still in school, so we hope these sessions helped answer some of those questions," commented Polen.



<u>Chrome Has New Privacy Settings - Here's What to Change Now</u> Adapted from The Washington Post, by Heather Kelly, 9/11/23

This past summer, Google came up with a new way to try to track what you do on the web to help advertisers target you. Google says this is better for your privacy than older tracking methods. But it's still tracking — and people who care about their privacy may want to shut it off. It's all part of Google's promise to phase out the use of cookies for tracking in Chrome.


What settings do I change?

From your Chrome browser, go to: Settings \rightarrow Privacy and Security \rightarrow Ad Privacy

You can also try this link in Chrome: chrome://settings/adPrivacy

You'll see three options and for maximum privacy, can turn them off, one by one. If the toggle is gray, it's off, and if it's blue, it's still on.

Ad Topics is a feature that uses your recent browsing history to detect what topics you're into and show you personalized ads. If you spent the week looking at dog sites, maybe you'll get an ad for a dog bed.



Google says these topics are deleted after four weeks and if you keep it turned on, you can see the list yourself. Turn this off.

Site-suggested Ads is an option that lets individual sites you've visited make similar conclusions about what you might be into (dog sweaters? hammocks?) and shows you ads for that on other sites. If you keep this on, you can later manually block individual sites from the same screen. But it's easier to just, yes, turn this off.


Ad Measurement lets different sites and advertisers share information about you to try to figure out how well their ads are doing. Turn this off.
