Hamid came to America from Morocco after winning a chance to immigrate through his country's lottery system. As a new permanent resident, he found support through a friend at his local mosque who offered him a place to stay and helped bridge the language gap with translator assistance.

Eager to build a better future, Hamid learned about OhioMeansJobs Stark & Tuscarawas Counties through word of mouth. He visited the center to explore opportunities and was approved for funding to pursue CDL training at MTC.

Just two weeks after completing his training, he secured a job with Western Express, earning \$26.25 per hour. Hamid is excited about getting his own truck and the opportunity to travel across the country.
